Accept your admissions offer in your student portal.
This is usually accompanied by paying an enrollment deposit. Ask about a fee waiver if you need one



- In March and April, review and accept your financial aid package, including loans, grants, and scholarships
- Activate your university email account and set up your student portal
- Apply and confirm on campus housing by the deadline
- Submit your health forms to your college or university. This includes immunization and vaccination records
- Complete the Senior Exit Survey in Naviance before graduation



- Sign up for DCPS Persists to receive resources and support throughout college
- Submit your final transcript to your college. Communicate your college plans to your school counselor or college and career coordinator

- Check your email for updates from your college about orientation, registration, and signing up for classes
- Attend DCPS Persists Summit and Send Off during the summer to learn everything about your transition to college, how to persist to graduation
- Expect to receive your first college bill during the summer
