Submit FAFSA as early as possible and make sure it is submitted with no errors. Correct any errors as needed on your FAFSA Submission Summary page



- Research if the schools you are applying to require the CSS Profile. If required, submit this information at cssprofile.collegeboard.org
- Sign up for the Dollars4College Scholarship Newsletter at <u>bit.ly/3sRIIIs</u>
- Write your scholarship application essays using Revision
 Learning resources as needed
- Track your scholarship applications in Naviance
- Submit DCTAG Application at <u>dconeapp.dc.gov</u> when it opens in the spring
- Apply for other local scholarships that apply to you, such as DC Mayor's Scholars and DC Futures
- Receive your financial aid award letters from the colleges you are accepted to. Share and review them with your school counselor or college and career coordinator
