FREE Fall Fly-In Programs Complete List

Fly-in programs provide underrepresented and diverse high school seniors with the opportunity to get a more in depth look at a college/ university through a FREE (housing and travel is typically covered) multi-day overnight visit.

Amherst College (Massachusetts)

Application Deadline: August 13 at 1pm EST

Program Dates: September 22 – September 24 or October 13 – October 15

Details: As part of Amherst College's commitment to diversity, the Office of Admission hosts two weekend Diversity Open Houses (DIVOH) in the fall to introduce prospective applicants to Amherst's campus, student body, faculty, classes, and residence halls.

Middlebury College (Vermont)

Application Deadline: August 13

Program Dates: October 7 – October 8

Details: Discover Middlebury is a program for seniors from traditionally underrepresented groups who are intellectually motivated and would like to pursue higher education at a small liberal arts and sciences college.

Emory University (Georgia)
